TPP UPDATES TO THE FTA TARIFF TOOL

- There are 6 TPP partners which the United States currently has a bilateral FTA with. These countries include Australia, Canada, Chile, Mexico, Peru, and Singapore.
- For these existing FTA countries, users can look up the tariff treatment under both TPP and the Bilateral FTA (Ex: Australia TPP or Australia Bilateral).
- Users may want to see the TPP tariff treatment to take into account rules of origin, which may be more flexible, if they manufacture their product with inputs from multiple TPP countries.
